## **Cultural Identity Reference Guide**

Hispanic : Of or relating to the people, speech, or culture of Spain.

**Latin** : Root of the five romance languages (Spanish, French, Italian, Portuguese and Romanian).

Latin America : Mexico, Central America, South America and the Caribbean.

**Latin American** : A person born in Latin America and/or having resided in Latin America for an extended period.

### Latino, Latina, Latin@

: A person that identifies with a country in Latin America, living in the U.S. – Usually born in the U.S. or having resided in the U.S. for an extended period.

#### Latinx

: Of, relating to Latin American heritage – Used as a gender-neutral alternative to Latino or Latina.

#### Spanish

: The people of Spain. : The spoken language of the largest part of Spain and of the countries colonized by Spaniards.
