

Housing Accommodation Options and Process

UCF is committed to providing reasonable housing accommodations for students with disabilities. Because UCF Housing offers numerous floor plans at various price points within a student's selected Housing Agreement Type, UCF Housing will offer students two options when Student Accessibility Services approves a floor plan accommodation. Students can select the option they determine best meets their approved accommodation while considering other factors that may be important to their housing experience.

- 1) The student may choose to have UCF Housing assign the student to the designated space that will best meet the approved floor plan accommodation. Assignments are completed prior to the start of online room selection and priority selection process.
 - With this choice, the student foregoes the priority room selection process and the option to select a space with preferred roommates. Preferred roommates are not considered part of the accommodation process. UCF's responsibility is to ensure the student receives the specific space deemed necessary due to disability.
 - When UCF Housing assigns the student to the space that best meets the accommodation, the student will be charged the base rate for their selected Housing Agreement Type.
 - In the rare occurrence that an accommodation is not available in the student's selected Housing Agreement Type, the student will be placed in available housing that best meets the student's accommodation. Student's will be charged the lowest base rate amongst their chosen and assigned Housing Agreement Type.
- 2) The student may choose to use the priority selection process for the housing assignment, which allows the student to choose a floor plan "at the front of the line" before other students select from the available housing spaces.
 - Students may elect to use this option if they desire to live with specific roommates. This option benefits the student who needs the accommodation and allows desired roommates earlier access to the selection process.
 - This option allows the student and their preferred roommates to potentially choose a floor plan with amenities beyond the most basic floor plan necessary to fulfill an accommodation.
 - Students who select a room type within their approved accommodation, will be charged the lowest base rate for their chosen Housing Community within their Housing Agreement Type. Students who select a room type with amenities beyond their approved accommodation, will be charged the rate of their selected room type.

UCF Housing will provide the student with the respective options at the time of notification of the approved accommodation. Any housing placement outcome is always pending availability, given the timing of a request and approval.
