

CREAR Futuros Graduate Assistantship

CREAR Futuros, which means "To Create Futures" in Spanish, is a peer-mentor based initiative designed to support Latino/a/x student success at UCF. CREAR (**C**ollege **Re**adiness, **A**chievement and **R**etention) Freshmen are paired with knowledgeable and highly trained upper-classman UCF Peer-Mentors that will introduce them to campus resources and offer insight on how to make the most out of their UCF experience. Although intentionally designed through a Latino-lens, students of any background are welcome to participate. This program is offered in partnership with the Hispanic Federation, Inc.

The CREAR Futuros Graduate Assistant coordinates and ensures the success of the CREAR Futuros program.

Position Responsibilities:

- Assist with planning and implementation of program including educational workshops and social activities.
- Provide ongoing support and training to peer-mentors
- Facilitate ongoing communications to peer-mentors, mentees, and campus partners
- ❖ Assist with content creation and online marketing strategy for promoting program activities and achievements
- Assist in programmatic data collection and assessment
- Maintain electronic program records (including confidential data)
- Facilitate communication between UCF Hispanic Serving Institution Initiatives and Hispanic Federation, Inc.
- Perform other Hispanic-Serving Institution duties as assigned.

Minimum Qualifications:

- Demonstrated experience in working effectively with students and staff
- Ability to work independently and collaboratively
- Strong written and oral communication skills
- Experience with Microsoft Office programs
- Experience with Qualtrics or JotForm
- Demonstrated commitment to serving a diverse student population

Graduate Assistantship Agreement includes:

- 1. Stipend 20 hours per week.
- 2. Graduate tuition waiver must be enrolled full-time (9 credit hours) fall & spring semesters; and
- 3. Paid health insurance.
