The University of Central Florida (UCF) was first federally recognized as a Hispanic-Serving Institution (HSI) by the U.S. Department of Education in January 2019. UCF is 1 of 3 HSIs in the State University System (SUS) of Florida. UCF is also 1 of 21 Research 1 (Very high research activity) HSIs in the country.

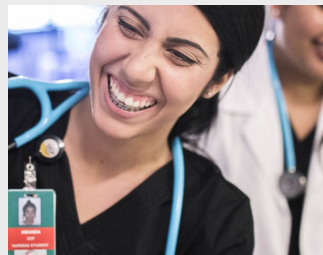
